



### Cleaning Messes and odor control

1. Clean all messes immediately.
2. If a patient urinates, defecates, or vomits, use the mop w/Kennel Sol or a disinfectant.
3. Anytime you use a mop in the lobby, place a wet sign in the wet area to warn clients.
4. If there is an unpleasant odor in the lobby use Febreeze and turn up the Aroma360
5. If you open windows to air out the lobby, make sure they get closed/locked at night.

### Cleaning Lobby Furniture

1. To clean and avoid staining use a damp cloth to clean the furniture in the lobby.
2. The furniture has been treated to withstand the germs our patients can bring into the hospital, so they do not need a deep clean on a regular basis.
3. If there was a contagious disease exposed to the furniture and you are uncomfortable leaving it out, remove the piece of furniture from the lobby and talk to Chris/Hana.
4. Do not use bleach or Kennel Sol on any of the furniture.
5. On the leather chairs you can use the leather spray, or a very damp cloth then dry immediately.
6. **Do not put bench cushion covers in the washing machine.**
