



Health Certificates

1. Review the “How to” info sheet on making a health certificate & look through the health certificate binder at the front desk/protocol (each state/country has different requirements.)
2. Patients are required to have a Rabies vaccine and a current exam. If the patient did not have the Rabies Vaccine at Tier 1, they must bring the rabies certificate as proof of vaccination.
3. Patients under 13 weeks of age are the exception to having a Rabies vaccine.
4. They must also have the address to where they are traveling to. It will be noted on the HC form.
5. After the health certificate is completed it must be scanned and uploaded into the file.
